# What you need to know about E15 fuel

Ethanol fuels are not new, but recent legislation targeting high-fuel prices has brought the biofuel back to the forefront of the conversation. What is this change and how will you be affected? It's pretty simple: Tuesday's announcement is merely an extension of a practice already in place seasonally. The announcement made by President Biden earlier this week will temporarily allow the sale of E15-blend gasoline through the summer months, a time period in which it is typically banned. This cuts the amount of fossil fuels in each tank by raising the ethanol content of each gallon sold from the typical 10 percent to 15. Ideally, wider availability of a more ethanol-rich fuel will insulate consumers (and their wallets) from high oil prices and supply-chain issues.

Can your car safely sip this new cocktail? A 5 percent increase in ethanol content is not anything over which most drivers should worry, as the vast majority of vehicles produced after 2001 are E15-tolerant. E15's compatibility with most 21st-century engines traces back to its first implementations in 2012 across a handful of midwestern states. The Environmental Protection Agency has previously been leery of approving E15 fuels for summer use due to the evaporation during warmer temperatures, which can lead to smog; hence why, in 2022, the wider availability of E15 expires this fall.

For classic car owners, E15 fuels are best avoided due to increased likelihood of corrosion from the ethanol content and probable system incompatibilities. For instance, traditional, rubber fuel lines are known to degrade faster with ethanol-blended fuels, which also result in increased deposits if fuel evaporates inside components like fuel pumps and carburetors.

Another issue, which applies to any vehicle running on E15, is the relative energy density of ethanol blends. Ethanol releases less energy when burned compared to gasoline. The 5 percent increase in ethanol content will cause fuel economy to dip, but the change would be about the same as a small change in driving style or variance in weather conditions (such as a light headwind). [Studies have proven this](#) decrease to be in the single digits: 3 to 4 percent fewer mpg when running on E10 rather than 100 percent gas, and 4 to 5 percent when using E15.

In short, this is a change that will have minimal impact on most drivers and their budgets. Classic cars and trucks should still avoid ethanol-blended fuels if possible. (There's little chance of E15 sneaking its way into your tank unannounced: Pumps must be labeled with what type of fuel the consumer is purchasing, and thus you will know whether you are putting E10 or E15 in your tank.) Use a site like [Pure-gas.org](#) to find whether there are stations near you with the option of ethanol-free fuels. Lower-ethanol, higher-gasoline fuel may be worth the extra coin for your classic engines, but don't fret over using E15 in modern vehicles that are used on a regular basis.

## Who's Who In MATC

### Featured Member(s): Earl & Judy Dickinson, former MATC Secretary



Judy and Earl currently live in York, Pennsylvania, but we began our life story in the Laurel Highlands of Western Pennsylvania. We met when Judy was attending nursing school. Earl had just been retired from the Army. We were married in September 1967. Life together in Maryland began in 1968, after Judy finished nursing school. Earl worked in the electronics industry, designing printed circuit board layouts for the space and communications industry. Judy worked as an RN in a Neonatal Intensive Care Unit. We are now both retired, living in Pennsylvania near our daughter and her family.

Earl married into a Thunderbird family. Judy's family only drove Fords. It was a family event to attend the yearly fall introduction of the new Ford models, including Thunderbirds, at the local dealership. The family shared garage space with an elderly neighbor who just happened to have a 1964 Thunderbird Landau. In the fall of 1965, Judy's Dad bought that Thunderbird and moved it to his own space. They drove the '64 until Judy's Dad bought a new 1970 Thunderbird. Her Mother refused to sell the 1964 so it was stored in their garage where it sat untouched until 1980. That is when Earl talked Judy's parents into giving them the Thunderbird with the promise he would restore it. He had the car trailered to our Maryland home before they had a chance to change their minds. The T-bird needed an engine tune-up, shocks, and a new brake system. After the repairs and a general clean-up, it wasn't bad. It still had some rust around the rear wheel wells and some dings on the door. We drove it to club events in that condition for many years.

Our 1964 Thunderbird had a complete restoration done in 1998. Over the years, we drove it to many local events and out-of-state ITC Conventions. Driving home from the Charleston Convention we got stuck in road construction, the heat was miserable without air conditioning in that car. We decided we needed a Thunderbird with air conditioning. In 2007 we bought our 2005 Retro Bird after seeing it advertised on e-bay. It was a local Maryland car with 2,165 miles on the odometer. We have enjoyed the air conditioning and driving it to MATC events ever since.

In the early 1980s, we joined the Mid-Atlantic Chapter of VTCI and continued as members until MATC and the International Thunderbird Club were formed in 1993. We are still members of MATC but left ITC in 2013. Earl is a past vice president of MATC in the '90s (with Dan Garvey as President). Earl is also a past district advisor for ITC and traveled several years to assist with convention planning. Judy is a past MATC secretary. We have enjoyed the fellowship and friends we have made over the past 41 years belonging to MAC/VTCI, MATC/ITC, and MATC. It's great being around like-minded people, enjoying each other's company and our Thunderbirds.
